Formed in 2017, Prismajic creates multi-sensory experiences that incorporate art, symbolism, music, lighting, technology and interactivity into remarkable and unique physical worlds. In 2019, Prismajic partnered with the Museum of Outdoor Arts in Englewood, CO to create the smash hit, *Natura Obscura*. The 5,500 square foot experience welcomed 55,000 people during its year long run.

In 2020 Prismajic built the company's 2<sup>nd</sup> experience, a 1,400 square foot pop up near City Park called *Shiki Dreams*. *Shiki Dreams* was ranked the 4<sup>th</sup> Best Immersive Art Experience in the nation by USA TODAY in 2021.

Jennifer continues to explore art, technology and the inner self to be of service to the community. She believes that by creating experiences that are rich in beauty and wonder, Prismajic will continue to spur self-reflective questions in the minds and hearts of their visitors.
